

## Illustration 24.1 Oakham High Street



Delivery vehicles to high street shops create obstructions to the traffic flow and can add to congestion problems at peak times, as does illegal parking.



Melton Road Level crossing adjoins the High Street and is a major cause of congestion through the whole of the town centre.

Bottom picture: Lorry turning into Church Street, an accident cluster site due to traffic turning right.

**Melton Road, Oakham, adjoins the High Street.**

Road bends and becomes very narrow here, as does the pedestrian pathway, leading to a small distance between pedestrian and vehicles. The 17<sup>th</sup> Century cottage of Jeffrey Hudson, the smallest man in England, is to the left side of the picture. A large number of HGV's travel through the town centre.
